In March 2020, the California Office of State Health Planning and Data issued its Report to the Legislature describing key aspects of the Health Care Payments Data Program.

Chapter 9 addresses Data Governance and covers data use, access and release (see sections starting on page 131). Topics include an overview of types of data products, data request applications, data use agreements, the role of a data release committee. The section also describes the collection and use of payment data.
